SANDBAR RESORT POLICIES & REGULATIONS

Failure to comply with these rules may result in eviction with no refund and future reservations cancelled.

Your Guests:

- You are responsible to ensure that your guests are aware of, and comply with, park rules and regulations.
- 6 persons are allowed per campsite with the reservation. 4 Adult 2 children.
- Check In/ Check Out:
- Check in at office and obtain a parking permit before proceeding to campsite. If you arrive after business hours, check in by 11 AM the following morning.
- Check in time is 2 PM. Guests who wish to check in *before* this time must specify this when making a reservation to ensure availability of your site at an earlier time. An additional in-early fee of \$20 is charged if arriving between 9 AM and 2 PM. An additional daily fee is charged if you are in your site before 9 AM.
- Check out time is 11 AM. If you wish to stay *later* than 11 AM, prior arrangements must be made through the office. Someone may have rented your site and a later departure may not be an option.
- Guests using Sandbar Resort trailer rentals must check out and request a walk-through before leaving the campgrounds.

Vehicles:

- All vehicles must have a permit/window tag displayed. Place on the dashboard, driver's side, visible out the window. Non-registered vehicles are subject to tow at the owner's expense.
- 1 vehicles maximum per site. Additional vehicles may be allowed as space permits 2 Max. An additional charge per allowed vehicle will be required. No 3rd vehicle must rent 2nd site.
- No parking in empty campsites. You will be charged if you do so. Extra vehicles can be parked in the overflow parking areas North of the restrooms or near the park entrance. Inquire at office for specific locations.
- Do not park any vehicle/boat under a cabana or on grass/beach areas. Damage to park utilities may result.
- No parking in front of dumpsters. You will be charged the fee assessed by the waste management company for an additional pickup because your vehicle blocked access.
- 5 mph speed limit throughout the park.
- The park is not a race course! Do not drive vehicles, including cycles, atv's, utv's, through the park other than to enter and exit the park. Driving in our storage area, through pedestrian paths, grassy area or other areas not considered entry/exit routes, could be grounds for ejection.

Pets:

- Dogs must be on a leash unless in water and under control in immediate area in front of rented site.
- The pet policy is posted and available from the office. Request a copy if you have a pet with you. You must comply with all pet policy rules and regulations.
- No pets are allowed in our rental units. You will be asked to leave with no refund and a cleaning fee of \$100 with assessed plus any damage.

Campsite Maintenance:

- If you or your guests damage park utilities, structures, etc. you will be billed for damages and repair costs.
- Maintain campsite in clean condition at all times. Secure your trash so as not to blow out of your site. Windy conditions are common on the River.
- Pick up and dispose of all trash before leaving the campgrounds. This includes all cigarette butts, bottle caps, tie wraps, other plastics, dog poop, etc. – ALL trash! YOU WILL BE ASSESSED A CLEANING FEE OF \$50 IF CAMPSITE IS NOT CLEAN!
- Place all trash in proper containers. Do not place hot coals into dumpsters! Items too large to fit into a standard 30 gal trash can (ezey up frames, sofas, mattresses, etc.) please take with you, must be disposed of offsite.

No guns, No fighting, No abusive behavior is allowed on site! No exceptions! You will be ask to leave with no refund.

Please take care of the premises. We work hard to make the grounds, restrooms, etc. clean and in good condition to accommodate you. Please help us keep it in good condition.
